#### Abstract Submission Guidelines

Abstracts are invited for NHIRI/NSA Symposium 2025, being held on the 8<sup>th</sup> December at the Joondalup Resort (Lake View East) in Joondalup, Western Australia.

We invite HDR students who have recently submitted their thesis or have results to present, to submit an abstract.

#### **Eligibility & Conditions**

- 1. Presenter must be a higher degree student (Masters or PhD).
- 2. Presenter must be a current NHIRI or NSA member.
- 3. Presenter should submit the abstract by themselves. Abstracts submitted by a person other than the presenter, will not be accepted.
- 4. Presenter must be available to present in person on the day of the symposium (8<sup>th</sup> December 2025).
- 5. Abstract must be approved by all authors.
- 6. Closing date for abstract submission is 30/09/2025 by 5 pm AWST.
- 7. Presenter must register for the symposium when submitting the abstract.

## Assessment Criteria

- 1. Abstracts will be reviewed and selected at the discretion of the NHIRI and NSA organisers.
- 2. Applicant supervisors and co-authors are classified as conflicted and as such will not be invited to assess abstract submissions or judge presentations.
- 3. Abstracts will be reviewed based on the originality of the work, the quality of the research design and data presented, and the impact of the research.
- 4. Applicants must name the conference where the work was been previously presented or will be presented (if applicable).
- 5. Finalists will be invited to present a 3-minute flash talk (plus 1-minute questions), dependant on number of abstract submissions received.

#### Presentations

1. At the event, presentations will be judged for clarity and structure, and the quality of data presented.
